



Pack 3387 – Financial Assistance Request Form

It is Pack 3387's intention to use Pack funds to encourage participation in Scouting. Requests for financial assistance should be directed to the Cubmaster or the Pack Committee Chair. All requests will be kept confidential. Financial assistance can be given in various forms for Scout purposes: campership fees, clothing and equipment, books, registration fees, etc. No cash will be given directly to the Scout or family. Financial assistance will be granted based on financial need and availability of funds, which are limited. The financial grant might also include a time-based payment plan, if appropriate.

This form may be filled out either by the Scout or the parent/guardian of the Scout requesting assistance. If it is filled out by the parent/guardian, that person is speaking for the Scout (not themselves). A parent/guardian filling out this form is not required to inform the Scout of this request.
